The diapering, feeding, and nap times of children age 4 months to 18 months old will be reflective of the child's individual needs, as documented by the parent. The school day will also include various stimulating teacher initiated active learning opportunities which include story time, music and movement, sign language, and Montessori lessons.

Montessori lessons support:

- Movement—Activities to enhance hand coordination, grasping, transferring objects, releasing objects, and large and small muscle development.
- Sensory stimulation and development
- Language acquisition Teachers are deliberate with talking to students constantly, sign language creating foundation for cognitive growth.
